

ORDINANCE NO. 230

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT ALL-NIGHT PARKING ON CITY STREETS FROM OCTOBER 31 THROUGH APRIL 1 OF THE FOLLOWING YEAR

THE CITY OF WAKEFIELD HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1. ALL-NIGHT PARKING. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a motor vehicle or to cause or permit a motor vehicle to be parked or left unattended between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. of any day on any street of the City between the thirty-first day of October and the first day of April of the following year.

Section 2. VIOLATION. Violations of this ordinance are a civil infraction. The penalty for a first offense is \$75. The penalty for any subsequent offenses is \$150. Each day of violation is a separate or subsequent offense. In addition, the offending vehicle may be towed and impounded at the owner's expense.

Section 3. CONFLICT AND REPEAL. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are repealed.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. The adoption of this ordinance is hereby declared an emergency effecting the public peace, health and safety and this ordinance shall, therefore, be effective immediately upon its adoption.

Section 5. PUBLICATION. After its adoption, this ordinance or a summary thereof, as permitted by law, shall be published by the City Clerk in a newspaper of general circulation in the City.
