

ORDINANCE NO. 225
AMENDMENT OF CODE #54.24(b)(2)(c)—
DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS

The City of Wakefield hereby Amends Code #54.24(B)(2)(c) as follows:

(c) That any customer disputing the correctness of his/her bill shall have a right to a hearing at which time he/she may be represented in person and by complaint and contentions to the City Official in charge of utility billing. This official shall be authorized to order that the customer's service not be discontinued and shall have the authority to make a final determination of the customer's complaint, but in no event shall any adjustments to a bill for any reason be retroactive more than three (3) months.

All other provisions of Code #54.24 shall remain in full force and effect.


EFFECTIVE DATE

This Amendment to Code #54.24(B)(2)(c) become effective fifteen (15) days after the date of its enactment.


