APPROVAL Anderson moved, Vestich seconded, to approve the agenda  
OF THE as presented. Motion CARRIED, all voting yes by roll  
AGENDA call vote.

NEW a) Storage Containers- Discussion relating storage  
BUSINESS container Ordinance took place. The Planning Commission  
looked at whether to allow, where, how many, and how they  
would need to be placed. Containers would be allowed in  
R-3(limits 1) and Industrial(more than 1), not allow in  
R-1, R-2, C-1, C-2 and Open Land zones. Containers need  
to be either on a pad or blocks with one year. The City  
Manager will work on the wording and present the  
information to the Planning Commission at the next  
meeting. Delfavero moved, Movrich seconded, to recommend  
that the City Council put a moratorium on any new storage  
containers until the ordinance is in place. Motion  
CARRIED, all voting yes by roll call vote.

ADJOURN Movrich moved, Vestich seconded, that the meeting be  
MENT adjourned at 7:13 P.M. Motion CARRIED, all voting yes by  
roll call vote.
