- The five members serve five-year terms. There are two alternate positions.
- Meetings are held on the forth Wednesday of the month at 5:00 pm at the Wakefield Public Library.

Requirements & Duties

- Resident of the City of Wakefield or Wakefield Township
- Attend monthly meetings
- May be required to attend other meetings or volunteer at special events to promote work of the committee.
