INVITATION TO BID

Repair of roads from emergency water line repair and weather damage.

May 24, 2022

The City of Wakefield is accepting proposals for the reconstruction and resurfacing of the attached list of repair sites at various locations throughout the City. All work is to be done according to Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) Specifications. Below is the scope of work that may include earth excavation, curb/gutter/walk replacement, Saw cut existing HMA in a rectangular fashion to square up repair site, aggregate base, hot mix asphalt paving, the maintenance of traffic, traffic control, and restoration work in the City of Wakefield.

Specifications:

- A. The contractor shall prepare the site, including saw cutting existing HMA rectangularly and removing spoils.
- B. All manholes and water valves, boxes, or curb stops must be adjusted flush or slightly below .5” of the HMA surface.
- C. All asphalt must come from an MDOT-certified plant with an MDOT-certified mix design.
- D. The contractor must prepare the site using industry standards
- E. Minimum 3” depth of HMA
- F. Traffic maintenance shall be according to the Michigan Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MMUTCD).
- G. Payment shall be made by lump sum per location.
- H. The contractor must furnish a list of Subcontractors and as to what portion of the work they are performing.

The contractor must provide proof of appropriate insurance to perform the work.

Sealed proposals with the enclosed forms will be received at the City of Wakefield, 509 Sunday Lake Street, Wakefield, MI 49968, until 11:00 AM on June 10, 2022, at which time all proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud. Envelopes must be marked “Road Repair.”

All work must be completed no later than July 11, 2022. Notice to Proceed will be issued with the award and signed contract.

The City of Wakefield reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids.

The contractor receiving the bid award shall provide proof of insurance prior to the commencement of work. Insurance shall be kept current and in full force throughout the duration of the work. The contractor shall show satisfactory evidence that they have performed similar work previously and have adequate equipment and labor to perform the work in a timely fashion.

The contractor may provide a cost per square foot including site preparation (A), or may provide a cost per square foot excluding site preparation (B), or may provide both.
